Supervision and enforcement

Two-tiered supervision and enforcement



EU level

European Commission, through European Al Office, exclusively enforces generalpurpose Al models compliance

Enforcement powers

- monitoring implementation and compliance
- initiating investigations
- requesting documentation and information
- conducting evaluations
- requiring corrective actions or measures
- restricting availability or requesting withdrawal or recall of AI models
- imposing fines up to EUR 15 million or 3% of the global annual turnover

2 Member State level

Competent national authorities enforce all other AI systems compliance

Enforcement powers

- monitoring compliance
- investigating complaints and initiating investigations
- requesting documentation and information
- conducting inspections
- requiring corrective actions or measures
- restricting availability or requesting withdrawal or recall of AI models
- imposing fines up to EUR 35 million or 7% of the global annual turnover
